SUBJECT : Annual Conference of the President's Committee  
 on Employment of People with Disabilities

1. Purpose. To announce the 46th Annual National Conference of the President's Committee on Employment of People with Disabilities, May 12-14, 1993, at the Cervantes Convention Center, St. Louis, Missouri.

2. Background. This year's meeting will be the 46th Annual National Conference sponsored by the President's Committee on Employment of People with Disabilities. The conference is recognized for the opportunities it offers attendees to learn about the latest developments, pilot projects and model programs relating to employment of people with disabilities; and to view exhibits of recent technological aids and equipment designed to help people with disabilities.

3. 1993 Conference. This year's conference is being held in St. Louis, MO., May 12-14. The conference theme is "ADA: Gateway to Opportunity." The conference will offer attendees an opportunity to select from over 50 workshops on ADA implementation, advancing employment of people with disabilities, and empowerment. Workshops will be held to address issues raised by businesses, government, service providers, organized labor, the disability community, and other concerned publics on the full range of subjects related to the employment of people with disabilities.

The ADA is in its third year of implementation. An assessment will be made of its effectiveness to date and advanced training on its next phase of implementation will be provided.
