**SUBJECT:** Notice of Program Year (PY) 2011 Final Youth and Adult Allotments for the WIA, Section 166 Program.

1. **Purpose.** To provide final PY 2011 funding allotments for the Supplemental Youth Services Program (SYSP) and Comprehensive Service Program (CSP).

3. **Background.** The Full-Year Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011 (the Act) was enacted April 15, 2011. The Act required the Secretary of Labor to make a reduction of 0.2 percent to all Fiscal Year 2011 Federally-administered programs, including the WIA Section 166 program. Additionally, INA youth funding is based on the WIA Youth Activities appropriations, which decreased by 10.4 percent. These two factors decreased INA youth funding by 10.6 percent. This makes \$12,388,708 in INA youth funding and \$52,652,484 in adult INA funding available for PY 2011. Under WIA, the Employment and Training Administration will also reserve 1.0 percent of funds for Training and Technical Assistance purposes.

Attachments F and G of TEGL 22-10 provided funding allotments for WIA Section 166 grantees. These allotments were provided for planning purposes only and were not an official commitment/obligation by the Department. This TEGL provides the authorized PY 2011 funding allotments for WIA Section 166 SYSP and CSP (including the 0.2 percent rescission).
