**SUBJECT:** Release and Availability of the *Comparison of State Unemployment Insurance Laws 2018*

- 1. Purpose.** To announce the release and availability of the *Comparison of State Unemployment Insurance Laws 2018*.
- 2. Background.** Each year, the U.S. Department of Labor publishes a new edition of the *Comparison of State Unemployment Insurance Laws* to reflect recent changes to state laws and areas of interest.
- 3. Publication Description.** This publication provides in-depth information on key aspects of state unemployment insurance programs such as coverage, financing, monetary entitlement, extensions and special programs, nonmonetary eligibility, overpayments, and appeals. It also provides an overview of the temporary disability insurance programs operated in six states.
