SUBJECT: Virtual Federal/State Unemployment Insurance (UI) Tax Summit

1. **Purpose.** To announce that the Employment and Training Administration (ETA) will host a Virtual Federal/State UI Tax Summit August 20 – 22, 2019.
2. **Action Requested.** ETA requests State Administrators to provide this information to all staff responsible for performing UI tax-related activities and allow staff to participate in the virtual conference.
3. **Summary and Background.**
 - a. Summary – ETA recognizes the need for training, technical assistance, and information focused on UI tax issues. To help address this need, ETA is hosting the Virtual UI Tax Summit, which will cover topics of interest to state staff performing UI tax-related activities.
 - b. Background – This virtual summit will provide a forum for ETA National and Regional Office UI tax staff to provide timely information and guidance to state UI tax staff. It will also provide a platform for states to share promising practices that create efficiencies and promote integrity in state UI tax operations.
4. **Conference Information.**
 - a. **Target Audience.** ETA strongly encourages state UI Tax Chiefs and Managers, UI Tax program specialists, Tax Performance System reviewers, and Tax Data Validation staff to register and participate in the Virtual UI Tax Summit.
 - b. **Dates and Times.** The Virtual UI Tax Summit will be held August 20 – 22, 2019, from 2:00 PM – 3:30 PM Eastern Time (ET) daily.
 - c. **How to Participate/Registration.** There is no costs to participate in the Virtual UI Tax Summit. ETA’s Regional Offices will send WebEx invitations to state UI tax staff.
 - d. **Topics.** The Virtual UI Tax Summit will provide an overview of employer liability and approaches to addressing ETA standards for determining and reporting employers

subject to state UI coverage provisions. It will also facilitate a discussion on strategies states use to perform audits and safeguards used to protect the integrity of audits. Finally, an interactive information exchange session will highlight state strategies to address worker misclassification. The schedule is outlined below.
